<b>Mediatrix</b>	Unfocused Mystifier – Abuses “mystique” to gain attention	Let a pursuit of knowledge serve as an excuse to hide from life	Realizing that a narrow focus can provide answers in the same manner as a diffuse focus	Understanding that reason can be an effective way to cull falsehoods from truth
<b>Seeker</b>	Reckless Manipulator – Uses people and then moves on once bored	Confuse irresponsibility with being an “individual”	Realizing that the “rules” do have their place in helping to manage ourselves and others	Understanding that at times it is necessary to mirror the potential in others
<b>Companion</b>	Fickle Dependent – Bounces between relationships without ever really connecting	Lose self while trying to mirror the potential of others	Realizing that standards of behavior can encourage psychological health rather than just limit individuality	Realizing that it is at times necessary to have others mirror own personal potential
